

Golf Advisory Board  
Regular Meeting  
April 24, 2019

Members in attendance were Dan Birnley (Men's Rep.), Claudia McNair (Women's Rep.), Dimery Plewe (Youth Rep.), Golf Pro Micah Rudosky, Golf Course Superintendent Tom Kramlich, and Director of Parks and Recreation Dean Palmquist.

Nicci Crowley, Bill Lewis, and Gary Unrein were guests in attendance.

The meeting was called to order by Dan Birnley at 7:01 AM with the minutes approved from the March 27, 2019, advisory board meeting.

**Pro Report** – Micah shared that the Par 3 Challenge Tournament on April 20<sup>th</sup> had 80 players and the CMGA Ice Breaker 3 Man Scramble on May 4<sup>th</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> is the next tournament coming up. Micah said that he is charging full price now, since the golf course is playing at normal course conditions. Micah stated that he has added new 25 golf rental gas-powered carts to his fleet, and they are much quieter than the older models. Micah said that the youth will have the opportunity to continue golfing in the PGA Junior League this coming Summer.

**Staff Report** – Tom mentioned that the MVI irrigation water was turned on April 8<sup>th</sup>. Tom shared that 3 seasonal golf workers started on April 8<sup>th</sup>, and 5 seasonal golf workers are returning and 3 seasonal golf workers are new hires. Tom stated that one of the smaller pumps was replaced in the pump house, and that the rough mower was being delivered April 24<sup>th</sup>. Dean shared that the Colorado Life Magazine ad for the Conquistador Golf Course was approved for print and will be in their next issue.

**Men's Association Report** – Dan shared that the match play league has started through the men's golf association and the CMGA 2-man Best Ball Tournament is scheduled for June 22<sup>nd</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**Women's Association Report** – Claudia said that the women's golf association is excited about the Memorial Flag Pole Project that will be happening this year on the northwest corner of the pro shop. Claudia shared that a new format will be taking place this year for the CWGA Tee Cup with a 9 hole scramble on Monday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, and then the 18 hole tournament on Tuesday, August 13<sup>th</sup>.

**At-Large Report** – No report.

**Youth Report**- Dimery reported that the local girls' high school golf tournament was held at our course on April 23<sup>rd</sup> with 65 players from 7 high schools. As mentioned by Micah as well, plans are underway for the youth golf camp and the PGA Junior League.

**Council Report** – No report.

**At-Large Interview** – Two interviews were conducted for the at-large position with Nicci Crowley and Bill Lewis. Following their interviews, the voting members of the golf advisory board deliberated and then unanimously recommended that Sam Jarvis serve another 3-year term. Dean stated that he will draft a memo and bring that recommendation before the Council for final approval at their May 14<sup>th</sup> meeting.
