



Highway & pedestrian crossing improvements in Cortez

Project also improves sites along CO 145 in Dolores and Rico

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Colorado Department of Transportation and contractor Oldcastle SW Group have a project underway to improve the driving surface of several stretches of highways in Cortez, Dolores and Rico. The project will also upgrade several ramps at select intersections to meet standards mandated by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

PROJECT SCHEDULE

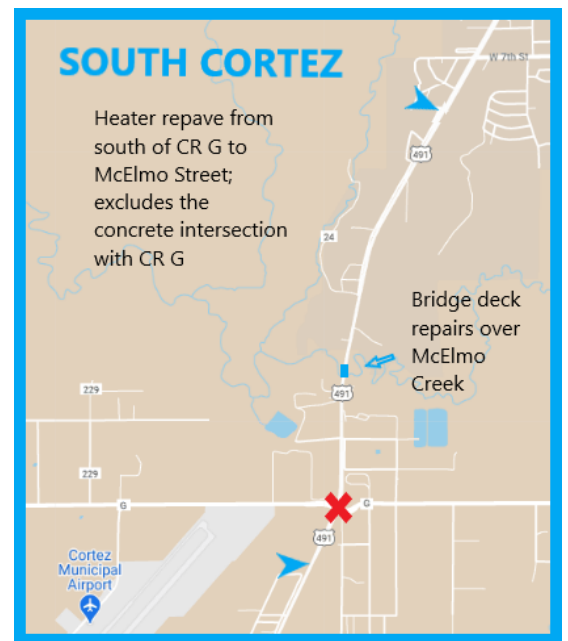
Mid-March to Mid-October 2021

EAST CORTEZ: Mid-March with ADA ramp work in east Cortez, at: Trinity, Cactus, Texas, Veach, Edith and Roger Smith. Repaving will be done between Mildred Street and the Fun Center likely starting in mid-May and continuing for three weeks.

SOUTH CORTEZ: Repaving will be done from a half mile south of CR G to McElmo Street, skipping the intersection at CR G, which is concrete; and the bridge deck at McElmo Creek will be repaired. The repaving is expected to start in late April and take two to three weeks to complete.

TRAVEL IMPACTS

- Work hours are approximately 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., with single-lane closures during repaving from late April to June
- No lane closures between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.
- Single-lane closures and sidewalk closures, 24/7, at intersections with ADA ramp construction, for a period of up to two weeks
